In 1991 the Church Pastoral Aid Society (CPAS) transferred the bulk of its existing archive to the University of Birmingham Library on deposit. A limited archive, mainly of more modern material, has been retained by the CPAS at its headquarters in Leamington Spa.

The collection of manuscript and printed items held at the University of Birmingham Library comprises not only items relating to the CPAS but also records of a number of other societies carrying out related activities.

The Church Pastoral Aid Society

The Church Pastoral-Aid Society was founded in the committee room of the Church Missionary Society on 19 February 1836 'for the purpose of benefiting the population of our own country by increasing the number of working clergymen in the Church of England, and encouraging the appointment of pious and descreet [sic] laymen as helpers to the clergy in duties not ministerial' (G R Balleine, *A history of the Evangelical party in the Church of England*, London, 1908, pp 176-177).

The CPAS records deposited comprise minute books, registers of legacies and grants, runs of annual reports and other publications, together with miscellaneous other manuscript and printed items.

As well as the records of the CPAS itself, there are items relating to a number of the so-called Auxiliaries, or local associations of

the CPAS, and to the Church Pastoral Aid Trust, a body established to acquire and hold property on behalf of the CPAS.

Note: Originally called the Church Pastoral-Aid Society, the hyphen was dropped from the name in about 1974. This later form of the name has been used in this catalogue, except where the original form appears in the title of a publication.

The Church of England Scripture Readers' Association

The object of the Association, which was founded in 1844, was 'to strengthen the parochial organisation of the church in London, by the employment of paid lay workers to assist the clergy of the poorest and most crowded parishes, within the metropolitan area' (Official year book of the Church of England 1894, p 669).

The CPAS 'came to the relief of Evangelical clergy by supporting extra staff in needy parishes... Its work was supplemented by the Scripture Readers' Association, begun in 1844 and consolidated as an Anglican society in 1849, supporting men who neither preached nor distributed literature' (D W Bebbington, *Evangelicalism in modern Britain*, London, 1989, p 119).

One minute book is held, containing minutes of meetings of the Association from March 1844 to June 1847.

The Church of England Scripture Readers' Friendly Society

Members of the Church of England Scripture Readers' Association were eligible to join the Friendly Society, which was established to assist them and their families, by providing death and sickness allowances and pensions.

The minute book in the collection records minutes of committee and annual general meetings of the Society from 1872 to 1874.

The Clerical Education Aid Fund, London Clerical Education Society, and London Clerical Education Aid Society

There were Evangelical clerical education societies in at least four towns and cities - at Elland (founded in 1777), Bristol (1795), Creton (1812) and London.

In London the London Clerical Education Society (founded in 1816) amalgamated in 1876 with the Clerical Education Aid Fund (founded in 1845) to form the London Clerical Education Aid Society.

The items deposited include minute books and cash books of the three above named London societies, together with runs of annual reports issued by the Clerical Education Aid Fund and the London Clerical Education Aid Society.

The Society for the Relief of Poor Pious Clergymen

The Society was founded in 1788. Its full title was 'The Society for the Relief of Poor Pious Clergymen of the Established Church Residing in the Country'.

The items relating to this Society comprise rough minute books, financial records and printed annual reports.

This series of minute books, 1840-1949, contains the minutes of meetings of the General Committee and the Sub-Committee (ie Grants and General Purposes Sub-Committee, which from 17 May 1898 was renamed the Executive Committee). Also included are minutes of some meetings of the Finance Committee, 1899 onwards, and occasionally minutes of other committees. Minute books for the period 1842-1857 were lost as a result of enemy action in World War II. At the same time some of the remaining minute books in the series were damaged. There are also no records of meetings held between 22 April 1892 and 18 Dec 1893.
